The only nonprofit organization in Greater Cleveland providing new school-appropriate shoes, clothes, and school supplies to students and teachers at no cost throughout the year through a network of schools and community organizations.

2023 WAS A MILESTONE YEAR FOR SHOES AND CLOTHES FOR KIDS

Building on the dream of the organization's founders, SC4K moved its entire operations to the Greater Cleveland Food Bank's new Community Resource Center. In preparation for this big move which consolidated multiple facilities, SC4K strengthened its infrastructure, promoting Monica Lloyd to Executive Director and adding staff in the critical areas of development, communications, and programs.
