Our continued partnership with the **CHRIST CHILD SOCIETY OF CLEVELAND** provided **2,000 CUYAHOGA COUNTY STUDENTS** with back-to-school uniforms, socks, underwear and school supplies.

CLEVELAND KIDS IN NEED RESOURCE CENTER
A SHOES AND CLOTHES FOR KIDS PROGRAM



Our **CLEVELAND KIDS IN NEED RESOURCE CENTER** served more than 4,300 Cuyahoga County school teachers last year, **HELPING DISTRIBUTE OVER \$3 MILLION IN SCHOOL SUPPLIES** to students in 13 local districts including a new piloted on-line ordering system.



The Cleveland Browns-sponsored Special Teams Package program **CONTINUED TO REACH 2,000 CMSD STUDENTS** and **HELPED DRIVE UP ATTENDANCE BY NEARLY 25%** for many recipients in the first 30 days after receiving the items. We've used the success of this program to redesign our other clothing-related programs.



Community **VOLUNTEERS DONATED 10,000 HOURS** of service to the organization – the equivalent of four full-time employees.



SC4K began work on a **THREE-YEAR PILOT PROGRAM** that may **SUPPORT NEARLY 1,000 K-3 STUDENTS** with improved attendance and reading skills. Watch for details in August 2019.



SC4K is shifting to a targeted purchasing model, ensuring access to school uniforms and complete outfits to the **10,695 CHILDREN SERVED THROUGH CLOTHING PROGRAMS AND OUR 28 NEIGHBORHOOD DISTRIBUTION PARTNERS**.



We established an organizational fund at **THE CLEVELAND FOUNDATION** as part of our long-term growth strategy, and we now have access to their expertise in planned giving and development support.
