ART THEMED TEACHER SHOP



In many schools, school art programs are not a high priority due to a lack of funding. As art supplies typically cost more than core supplies, art teachers often spend their own money to buy supplies for their projects. SC4K is helping to eliminate this obstacle in classrooms where at least 60% of the students enrolled are eligible for the National School Lunch Program by providing an Art-Themed Teacher Shop. Art teachers are invited to this exclusive shop where specialty art and craft supplies are featured in addition to the standard 'art' and other school supplies. Typically, there is no limit on the quantities of items a teacher can receive during this special shop.

All eligible and registered art teachers are invited to participate. In most schools, budgets only allow for one dedicated art teacher, and they are responsible for art projects for the whole school. This shopping experience allows teachers to acquire materials and equipment that elevate the quality of art projects for their students. Further, supplies can be used for years to come.

Since SC4K introduced this specialty shop in 2019, 991 art teachers have shopped and received art supplies worth \$1,085,145.

KICKS 4 KIDS CAMPAIGN



Shoes and Clothes for Kids does an excellent job of preparing kids with the necessary items to head back to school. Throughout the year, SC4K offers teacher and partner shopping opportunities so that needed or worn-out items can be replaced. By spring, many new items kids receive for "back to school" are worn or no longer fit. In 2021, on National Shoe Day (March 15th), SC4K introduced the Kicks 4 Kids Campaign to raise funds to purchase new shoes and shoe shopping passes so kids can choose their own at local stores. The new "kicks" will replace their worn-out, outgrown shoes. Students are prepared for the remainder of the school year and ready for spring and summer fun outside.

Since 2021, \$94,461 has been raised to give away 3,778 pairs of shoes!

BACK TO SCHOOL CAMPAIGN



Each year, Shoes and Clothes for Kids (SC4K) prepares kids with the necessary items to head back to school. Throughout the year, SC4K offers teacher and partner shopping opportunities so that needed or worn-out items can be replaced with new items at no cost. These opportunities directly impact the mission of SC4K, which is to improve school attendance by eliminating the lack of appropriate shoes, clothes, and school supplies as barriers.

In 2017, SC4K became an affiliate of the Kids in Need Foundation (KINF), whose mission is to help create equitable learning spaces by distributing supplies and resources, investing in teachers and students in underserved schools. Through their network, SC4K added new school supplies for students and teachers to our distribution catalog. SC4K supplements the "free school supplies and products" through our annual Back to School Campaign. The campaign is dual purpose - a fundraiser to seek donations during a critical time of year for families ("Back to School Season") and a promotional campaign to leverage SC4K's print, TV/radio, and social media communication channels.

Since 2002, \$10,528,707 has been raised preparing kids for the new school year.

STEM THEMED TEACHER SHOP



STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) education helps students develop a well-rounded foundation of skills that can help them succeed in many career fields. With an emphasis on innovation, problem-solving, and critical thinking, STEM learning is critical for Ohio's K-12 students to cultivate the next generation of workers.

Teachers across all grade levels require specific resources and supplies to create and carry out STEM-based curriculum, class projects, and homework assignments. These resources vary from standard core school supplies and include items such as building materials, electronics, consumables, robotics supplies, and safety equipment, in addition to STEM learning kits.

SC4K is helping to provide support for educators in classrooms where at least 60% of the students enrolled are eligible for the National School Lunch Program by providing a STEM-Themed Teacher Shop. All eligible and registered teachers will be invited to participate in this specialty shop, where STEM-focused items and STEM kits will be distributed in addition to regular school and classroom supplies. SC4K introduced this specialty shop in 2024, which will allow teachers to acquire materials and equipment that will elevate the quality of their STEM projects throughout the year.

WINTER DISTRIBUTION



Winter weather in Cleveland can be an obstacle for kids attending school who need proper footwear and clothing. Shoes and Clothes for Kids (SC4K) distributes new boots, winter coats, hats, and gloves to fulfill our mission: to break barriers to school attendance by providing new shoes, clothes, and school supplies to students in need.

For the last 25 years, utilizing a community-wide distribution network, SC4K has reached neighborhoods with the greatest need. The distribution network encompasses 24 social service agency partner sites in Greater Cleveland. The agencies provide a detailed list of winter items they need, including the size and gender of each student served, so students are prepared to attend school when inclement weather comes.

Orders are pulled from SC4K inventory and packaged. Because of the large quantities (each partner receives an average of 16 large bulky boxes), SC4K works with UPS and volunteers to deliver the order directly to community partners during our annual UPS Care Day event to say thank you for their hard work all year long on behalf of SC4K.

Your sponsorship of the Winter Partner Shop will allow SC4K to expand the program so kids do not miss a day of school due to a lack of appropriate boots or winter coats. As the "Presenting Sponsor," your organization receives recognition and participation in PR and media opportunities.

Since 2016, community partners have received and distributed \$7,575,259 worth of boots, coats, hats, and gloves impacting 21,590 kids so they can go to school prepared to learn.
