

TEACHER SHOPPING PROCEDURES

2025 - 2026 SCHOOL YEAR

ELIGIBILITY

Certified classroom teachers (includes art, health, media, music, and physical education) at eligible charter, parochial, and public schools in Cuyahoga County can shop once a semester, IN STORE at the SC4K Teacher Resource Center or ONLINE, for FREE classroom and student supplies.

To be an eligible school, 60% or more of the students enrolled must be eligible for the National School Lunch Program. Only educators from schools with a current SC4K Ambassador are eligible to shop.

PARKING & ENTRY

The SC4K Teacher Resource Center is at the west end of the Greater Cleveland Food Bank's Community Resource Center (CRC). The address is **15500 South Waterloo Road, Cleveland, OH 44110**. The CRC is easily accessible from I-90 at E. 152 St. exit.

- Park in front of the SC4K Free Store or by the loading docks on the west side of the building
- Use the MetroHealth/Shoes and Clothes Kids entrance and check in at the SC4K front desk
- Use drive-up docks at the west end of the building for loading your vehicle.
- Return all shopping carts to the building (inside).

SHOPPING RULES

Registration is required. No walk-ins. Our Teacher Resource Center is open during designated hours during the school year. Eligible staff can attend one regular teacher shop per semester (online sign-up required). No rollovers. Specialty shops (Art-Themed, Book Giveaway, STEM-Themed, Yoobi distributions, etc.) are in addition to your one regular shop. Appointment confirmations are sent to your school email address and are visible on your landing page.

SHOPPING RULES, cont.

- Shoppers must only take items needed in their classrooms and only in the quantities needed by your students, honoring all limits imposed on specific items. Items can be shared with other classrooms within your school.
- You cannot sell, barter, or trade items received, in accordance with IRS regulations.
- You are not allowed to bring guests to shop with you. Only scheduled teachers are allowed in the shopping area.

SC4K reserves the right to revoke a teacher's shopping privileges if these rules have been violated.

CHECK OUT PROCESS

Volunteers will inventor the teachers' items during check out teachers to ensure that the item limits have been honored and for SC4K record-keeping purposes. While boxes/bags may be available, teachers are encouraged to bring their own. Shoppers are responsible for transporting the items they select. SC4K will not deliver items and items will not be held for pick up by shopper at a later time or date.
